Geographical location

Salta Province occupies a strategic geographical position in the heart of South America. It borders three countries—Chile, Bolivia, and Paraguay—and six Argentine provinces—Jujuy, Formosa, Chaco, Santiago del Estero, Tucumán and Catamarca. The province encompasses a wide range of landscapes from 180 to 6700 meters above sea level, including the arid Puna desert in the west, the lush green Yungas, and valleys and steep ravines in the central region.

Air Connectivity

With over 100 weekly flights, Salta offers excellent connectivity for visitors. Domestically, the province is linked to several regions of the country. The national destinations that Salta connects with directly include **Buenos Aires, Rosario, Córdoba, Mendoza, Iguazú and Neuquén**.

Internationally, Salta is connected to **Lima, Perú; Asunción, Paraguay; and Panamá** these airports are key points for tourist arrivals. Lima and Panamá Airports, serve as a central connection point for Salta, offering links to Colombia, Mexico, Ecuador, the United States, the Caribbean, and Europe.

With its robust connectivity network, Salta becomes a gateway to the country and the southern part of the continent.

Valle Histórico y Gaucho

Río Juramento




The Río Juramento is favored by experienced anglers for its floatable sections, larger course, and exceptional golden dorado sizes. Anglers can cover many kilometers in a day, reaching inaccessible spots.

The river's transparent waters and rugged surroundings create an incredible environment where golden dorado can be seen and caught, with sizes ranging from 3 to 12 kg. The river's floatable sections are divided into three, so fishing programs typically last two to three days, with the possibility to extend or combine with two days of fishing in the Río Dorado.

The **dorado**, a formidable fish with a golden sheen, is famous for its aerial displays and bright golden colours when hooked.





Selva de Montaña

Río Bermejo

The Río Bermejo is dynamic in water flow due to the irregular seasonal rains. Despite this, its permanent flow creates numerous pools, offering unique environments for fish development.

The river carves through the shoreline, forming meanders and is home to various fish, including golden dorado, surubí, and pacú. Many of these fish are crucial for local diets. The river's tributaries are located within Baritú National Park in northern Salta, with fishing excursions starting from San Ramón de la Nueva Orán, 250 km from Salta.







Valle Histórico y Gaucho

Río del Valle



This river begins in the "El Rey" National Park, located in the subtropical mountain jungle of northern Salta. Inside the park, it is known as the río Popayan, where fishing is strictly prohibited. Beyond the park, the river continues as the río del Valle, where sport fishing is allowed.

It is a small river with very clear waters where shoals of sardines, bogas, catfish, and the sought-after golden dorado can be observed. Due to the wariness of the golden dorado, extra care is needed to catch them.

Rods

Rods for fishing in Salta, rods #6, #7, or #8 are appropriate. The #6 rod is highly recommended, but a #8 may be needed for casting large flies. Quick action rods are the best choice for this type of fishing, and saltwater rods are suitable for most conditions.



Reels

Reels designed for saltwater fishing are ideal, featuring strong and lightweight drag systems. Given the long days with many casts, the weight of the reel is significant. For optimal performance, choose a strong, lightweight reel that is well-balanced with the rod.
